Small Group Military Model

INTRODUCTION (5 minutes, including objective)

- There are many types of Bible study: topical, character, book, etc.
- There are different methods of conducting a Bible study, from formal lecture to private study.
- The choice of type and method depends on the group and objectives.
- The objectives of most Military Christian Fellowships include carrying out the Great Commission within the Armed Forces and helping members reach spiritual maturity.
- The experience of many nations is that the INDUCTIVE BIBLE STUDY is one of the most effective, although not the only way, to do this. It can be led by anyone with leadership abilities and does not require theological training.

PRESENTATION (10 minutes)

- A. Definition. An Inductive Bible Study is:
- 1. Study of a limited portion of Scripture, usually one chapter, sometimes less, seldom more.
- 2. Study by a small group, 6-8 people optimum, generally of approximately the same grade.
- 3. Study in an informal, discover style. Basically, a Holy Spirit guided self-study.

Inductive Bible Study Based on AMCF Reference Manual

Why Study the Bible?

"All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for <u>teaching</u>, <u>rebuking</u>, <u>correcting</u>, and <u>training in righteousness</u>, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work." (2 Tim 3:15-16)

- Teaching What is true and how to live (the right path)
- Rebuking Wrong attitudes, affections, motives, values, beliefs and behavior (got off the path)
- · Correcting Get back on the right path
- Training in righteousness Stay on the right path

Conversational Prayer

- The Bible Teaches us to pray.
- Prayer can be Public or Private
- Some Public Prayer is poor example
 - Stilted Language
 - "Holy words"
- Principles apply to public & private Prayer






DEFINITION

Conversational prayer is:

- 1. Talking with (not just to) God
- 2. Talking as a small Group
- 3. Talking in an informal, Conversational style




Pray and Plan

Discovering and Obeying the Heart of God

Why Pray and Plan?

- Planning is essential for Military/Police
- Wrong approaches to planning can lead to disaster
- Our plans often go wrong because:
 - We are fallible, feeble, and fallen (Jas 4:13-17, Ps 146:3-4; 2Chron 20:1-30, Ps 50:7-15, Jas 4:1-3)
 - · We don't know the future, but God does
- · God is working out His plan, not yours or mine
- The best plan is to be part of God's plan

If you plan before you pray, you might have to pray that God saves you from your plan.



AMCF ILLUSTRATED HISTORICAL REVIEW




British Army Ministry
