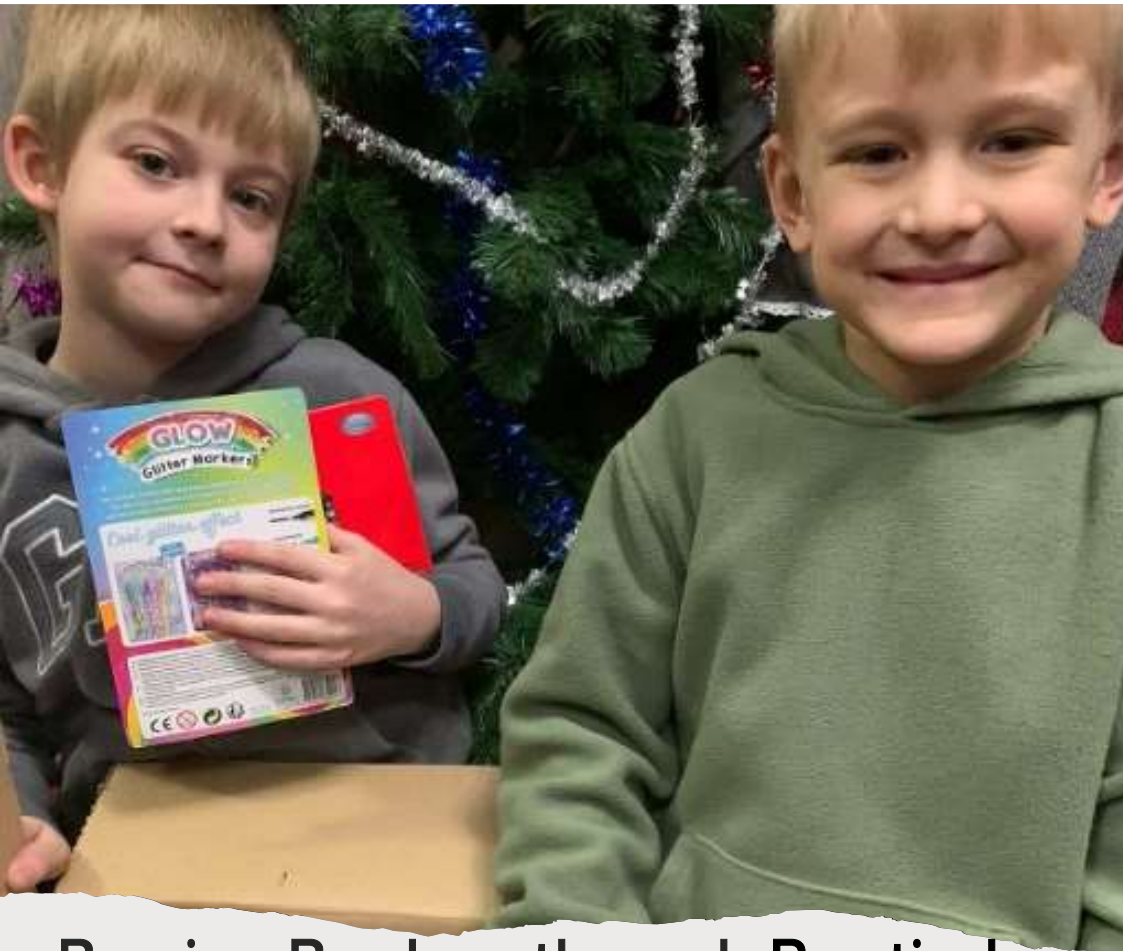
Women's Ministry is Integrated
