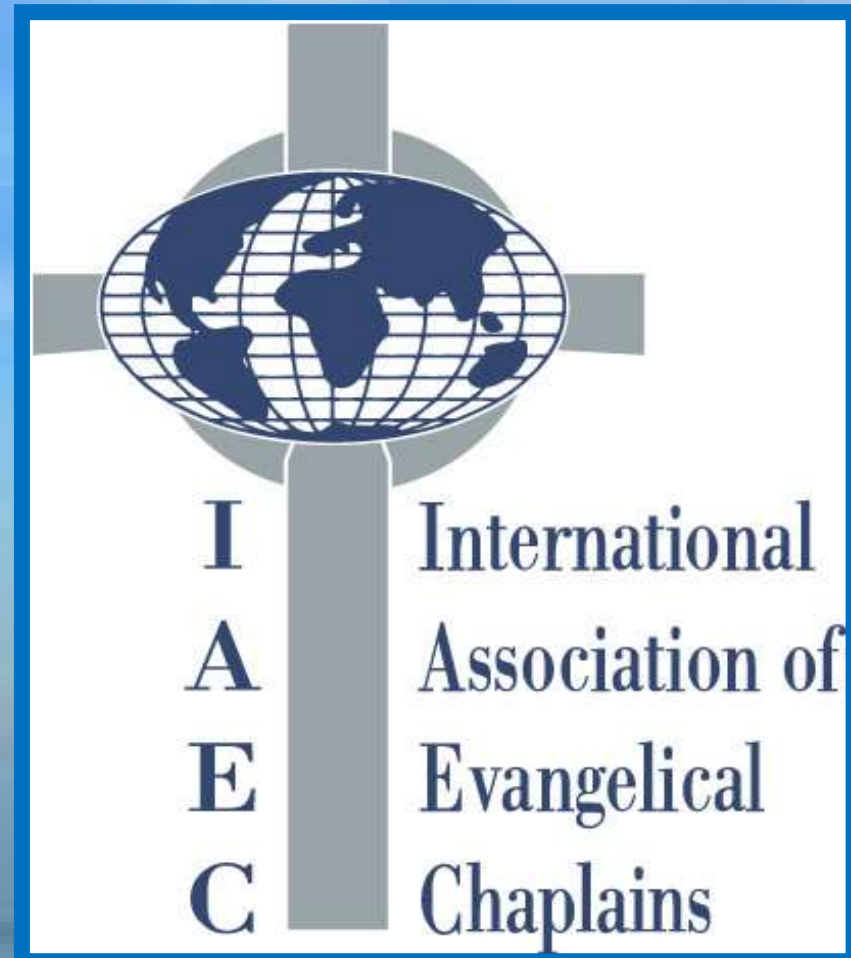

- Angolan delegates asked if there was a similar chaplain organization to AMCF
- CH Egdren, NAE Director, accepted challenge to create such a chaplain training organization

Regional Directors

- Due to Covid, recognized as a need in 2020 as a result of the IAEC Strategic Planning Group.
“IAEC needs a group of on-site Regional Directors and national contacts, globally organized by (1) language, (2) geography, and if necessary (3) politics, to represent IAEC and engage their uniformed services locally.”
- Approved at the May 2021 Board meeting
- Accountable to the Director for Training
- Accountable to the Executive Director and President for non-training issues
